The purpose of the Legacy of Excellence (LOE) summer enrichment programs offered is to help African American males with developing a clear sense of their attributes, talents, goals, and attitudes to enhance their self-image, self-esteem and build character. A Good Black Man, Inc. (AGBM) hopes that our learning modules will serve as yet another intervention strategy to help young people stay interested and engaged in the learning process.

THE L.O.E. SUMMER ENRICHMENT CAMP CURRICULUM

We have created two (2) learning modules to achieve our goals. The first, the LOE Life Skills Module, was designed to help the child(ren) develop an individual plan for self-improvement, and obtain skills for job searching, job retention and career management. The second, the LOE Computer Literacy Training Module, makes use of technological tools such as personal computers and our websites (www.agoodblackman.com and www.agoodblackman.org) to help camp participants develop an appreciation for the historical strength of the African-American family as well as reflect the positive contributions of their families, friends and the community in which they live.
